Allgemeine Bestimmungen:

1. Competition rules and conditions of participation: For the event are the Wettkampfbe- provisions (WB), the legal system (RO) and the Anti-Doping Code (ADO) of the German Swimming Association e.V. (DSV) in their version VALID. For padding swimming, the enclosed swimming rules apply. Only the athlete who is registered with the DSV and has paid the annual license fee is eligible to participate. This is to be insured with the message according to § 15 (1), 19 (2) WB-AT. For the 8-10-year-old athletes, the restrictions of the competition program and for the up to 7-year-old rules of the child-friendly competition apply due to the decision of the DSV-FA Swimming of 23./24.10. 2015 in the updated version of 04.11.2017. Et al Students who are 7 years old and under the age of 7 cannot complete more than 5 and 8-10 years do not complete more than 6 starts a day (including stints). This applies to the child-friendly competition WK 1 to 7 and to WK 8 to 16.“
2. Deposit wagers: “ All sports clubs and schools as well as their members can participate in the deposit bets. Participants in the competitions may also take part in the swimming pool under the condition that the youth protection regulations for swimming are respected. the 7-year-olds and the younger ones are not allowed to complete more than 5 and the 8-10-year-olds not more than 6 starts on this day (incl.
3. The sports health is to be confirmed for all participants with the notification according to 11 WB-AT
4. There are no disqualifications in the child-friendly competitions of the first section and in the entries E 8 - 12. Instead, 10 seconds are added to the floated time penalty for errors.
5. It starts after the two-start rule. There is manual timekeeping.
6. Competitions: “ Wartberg outdoor swimming pool in the city of Alzey. The competition pool is 25m long and has 6 runways separated by wave killer leashes. The water depth is 1.50 to 3.50 m. The water temperature will be about 23 °C.
7. The reports must be sent by e-mail (DSV6 format) by 11.06.2018 to: michael.haas@sc-neptun-alzey.de

8. The registration fee amounts to 4Euro per single entry and 6.50 Euro per relay entry (including pair swimming E 4). Over 51 entries, the entry fee is reduced by 0.50 Euro cents per entry. A bank account can be requested.
9. The classification will be made in the individual competitions for the 2003 and later years. The years 2002 - 1994 as well as 1993 and age are combined
10. Awards: All participants receive a certificate for each start. In all competitions and entries, with the exception of the family scale (E 7), the places receive 1-3 medals. The winning family of the family season will be awarded the trophy of SC Neptune Alzey.
11. Mixed Relays: All mixed teams must have at least one male and at least one female participant. The order is arbitrary.
12. Fighting court: The clubs are requested, depending on the number of reports, to provide a sufficient number of licensed referees (by name and with a specific request): from 6 to 15 reports 1 KR; from
13. 16 - 29 Messages 2 KR; from 30 messages 3 KR. Wanted entries will be considered if possible
14. During the duration of the event, the use of the non-swimmers' pool is prohibited, as far as the organizer can not guarantee supervision. However, if a pelvis is used by a competitor or an accompanying person / spectator, this is done at the own risk and on the sole responsibility of the participating club. The city of Alzey and the SC Neptune Alzey are exempted from liability claims. The City Alzey and the SC Neptune Alzey are not liable for any items they have brought with them.

15. Data protection: By submitting the notifications, the association declares that he and the registered assets agree to the storage of personal data and photos in the context of reporting on this event and also that the competition data are included in the reporting results, Competition protocols and leaderboards, also by electronic means, be published. It is intended to publish the report and the protocol on the website of SC Neptun 1894 e.V. Alzey
16. The event was displayed and registered under registration number 2018/024 / NA in the SWSV

General rules of deposits E *:

1. Unless otherwise stated for the discipline, it will start from the water
2. Unless otherwise specified for the discipline, the turn and stop are made with any part of the body on the wall (and not just with the aid!)
3. Tools must be removed after the stop and placed in the prescribed area. Only then will the time be stopped.
4. Season change with aids: Here you have to hit first, then transfer the aid" before the next participant starts."
5. The following aids are to be brought by the participants: fins, towel (minimum size 80 cm * " 40 cm). All other aids are provided by SC Neptun.

Special rules for the special disciplines of deposits: "

1. Towel transport: The towel must remain dry.
2. Board seats: Here the competitor must sit on the board throughout the course. A maximum of board loss per track is allowed.
3. Pair swimming: The rear float holds the legs of the front float with both hands. " After 25 m change, the first swimmer must stroke.
4. Fin swimming: It starts with fins. The fins are to be worn throughout the course and may only be taken off after the attack
5. Family Relay: Starts are allowed here. Participants must be at least two generations of the same family."
6. Board swimming: The board must be held with both hands during the entire route
7. Pool Noodle Swimming: The ascent takes place after the start whistle. The pool noodle is to be touched throughout the entire route
8. Ball Transport: The ball must be at least one arm in front of the body
9. Air Mattress Swimming: The ascent takes place after the start whistle. There are two (!) Swimmers active on each track, for a total of eight. The air mattress is to be touched by both floats during the whole journey. It is allowed to lie on the air mattress. At turn and finish only one swimmer has to strike. There should never be more than four swimmers in a team at the same time.
